We wish to inform you that our competition "FIRST PRIZE STUDENT ITALIAN GRAPHICS 2019"

has been very successful because of the high number of participants both from Italy and abroad.

This year we have **two types of winners:** one chosen by the **Jury** and the other by the **public of Facebook.**

The Jury, after having selected 116 works reached from 103 competitors, decided to the unanimity to attribute the **FIRST PRIZE**, ex aequo, to the Engravers:
